


WEF 2022 – Air space closure for civil aviation

- 1 The closure is issued relating to the air space for civil aviation in the greater area of Grisons as decreed by the Federal Council in application of the Art. 7 Aviation Act (LFG; SR 748.0) for the duration of the World Economic Forum, for a maximum period of May 20-28, 2022 (R-Area).
- 2 Within the R-Area, flights are permitted as a rule at proper facilities (airport Bad Ragaz, airport Samedan, Mounting landing zone Arosa, Heliport Balzers and Untervaz).
- 3 Within the R-Area, flights are permitted for multiple flights to landing locations designated by FOCA (BAZL) under compliance of Article 17 of the Off-Airport Landings ordinance. A responsible operator must be designated per Art. 17, para. 3 for potential landing locations. Moreover, users per Art. 17, para. 2 must submit a joint security and operational concept to FOCA in advance.
- 4 All off-airport landings for CAT (commercial air transport) flights relating to the WEF 2022 within the R-Area and outside the FOCA designated landing locations are prohibited.
- 5 Any off-airport landing location for multiple flights may not be located above 1100 m above sea level nor be located between Tiefencastel and Klosters (see the attached map).

- **7** For special flights (avalanche patrols, etc.), accredited pilots / aircraft may request an approval on short notice from the approval authority (PPR unit). The approval authorities decide as quickly as possible and issue a mission number and transponder code for approved flights.
- 8 The air space closure enters into effect on May 20, 2022 / 8 am and continues through May 23, 2022 / 5 pm at the latest.
