

WEF 2023 – Traffic orders

1 The Cantonal Police, Grisons and the Municipality of Davos issue the following, temporary traffic orders on the occasion of the WEF 2023 pursuant to Art. 3, para. 6 Swiss Road Act (SVG; SR 741.01):

The following traffic orders apply to increase safety for the entire road system within the Davos: They can be issued or rescinded based on the current situation in the period from Monday, May 2, 2022 through Saturday January 28, 2023 to the extent that individual traffic orders identify another time period.

2 Promenade

2.1 Closure of partial route at the Scaletta Street intersection to the English Church

Starting on Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 3 pm through Saturday, January 21, 2023 / 6 pm, the Promenade will be closed from the turn off Promenade / Scallettastasse to the English Church and traffic will be diverted via the Scalettastrasse. Approved travel is excluded from this measure (VBD until Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 10 pm and as of Saturday Saturday, January 21, 2023 / 5 am). Travel with permits is permitted between the Scalettastrasse intersection and the Hertistrasse.

2.2 Closure of intersection at the Montana crossing to Hotel Parsenn:

Starting Saturday, January 14, 2023 / 10 am through Saturday, January 21, 2023 / 6 pm, the Promenade in the area of Hotel Seehof, between the Montana intersection and the Hotel Parsenn will be closed. Travel with permits is excluded from this measure. Traffic will be routed to the Talstrasse in on-coming traffic.

2.3 On-coming traffic on the Promenade; Hotel Parsenn / Café Weber up to Scaletta street

Starting Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 10 am through Saturday, January 21, 2023 / 6 pm, the Promenade is open to on-coming traffic on the section between the corner Hotel Parsenn / Café Weber up to the intersection at the Scaletta street.

2.4 Scaletta parking lot

Starting Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 5 pm, to Saturday, January 21, 2023 / 8 am, part of the parking lot at Scaletta next to the access to Hotel Ameron is closed and reserved for the use of the police and WEF.

2.5 Symond parking lot

Starting Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 5 pm through Saturday, January 21, 2023 / 6 pm, a section of the parking lot at Symond is closed to the public and made available as required to the police and WEF.

2.6 Horlauben parking lot

Starting Monday, January 2, 2023 / 7 am through Monday, January 23, 2023 / 6 pm, the Horlauben parking lot is closed to the public and available as required to the police and WEF.

2.7 Library parking lot

Starting Friday, January 13, 2023 / 6 pm through Monday, January 23, 2023 / 6 pm, the library parking lot (Schweizer Haus) is closed to the public and available as required to the police and WEF.

2.8 *Kirchner Museum park*

Starting Monday, January 2, 2023 / 7:00 am through Saturday, January 28, 2023 / 6:00 pm, the Park at the Kirchner Museum is closed to the public and available as a waiting area for authorized vehicles and available as required to the police. Parking vehicles during the build-up and tear-down phases requires a permit from the municipality.

2.9 Separation of the sidewalk along the Promenade

Starting Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 5:00 pm through Saturday, January 21, 2023 / 6:00 pm, the Promenade is closed to pedestrian traffic between the Kongress Hotel and the intersection at Scaletta Street. Personnel accredited by WEF are excluded by these measures.

3 Talstrasse

3.1 Two-way traffic along the Talstrasse

Starting Monday, January 2, 2023 / 2 pm through January 28, 2023 / 6 pm, the Talstrasse (Tal Street) will be open to on-coming traffic between the Davos Platz train station and the Montana intersection.

3.2 Closure of Congress Center and parking lot

Starting January 8, 2023 / 7:00 AM , through January 23, 2023 / 6:00 PM, the Congress center parking lot is closed for security reasons and available as required for the police and WEF.

3.3 Closure of Metz parking lot

Starting Tuesday, January 3, 2023 / 7 am through Friday, February 10, 2023 / 6 pm the Metz parking lot is closed to the public and available as required to the police and WEF. Part of the parking lot is opened for seven HCD home games on Tuesday, January 3Friday, January 6, Sunday, January 22, Tuesday, January 24, Saturday, January 28, Tuesday, January 31, and Saturday, February 4, 2023.

3.4 Closure of sports center parking lot

Starting Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 7 am through Friday, January 20, 2023 / 6 pm, the entire sports center parking lot is closed to the public and available as required to the police and WEF. A limited number parking spaces are available as the alternative for visitors to the sports center.

3.5 No turn at intersection Talstrasse / Hertistrasse:

No left turns permitted as of Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 2:00 pm through Friday, January 20, 2023 / 6:00 pm on the Talstrasse in the direction of Hertistrasse (Congress side). Only right turns permitted from Hertistrasse (Kongress side) into the Talstrasse.

3.6 Closure Hertistrasse

Starting Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 6 pm through Friday, January 20, 2023 / 6 pm, the Hertistrasse will be closed to pedestrians and vehicles between the Promenade and Talstrasse. Personnel accredited by WEF and residents are excluded by these measures.

3.7 Closure Richtstattweg

Starting Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 5 pm through Friday, January 20, 2023 / 6 pm, the Richtstattweg will be closed between the Promenade and Scalettastrasse. Residences and police vehicles are exempted from this measure.

3.8 Closure of Panorama parking lot at the ice stadium

Starting Monday, January 2, 2023 / 7 am through Thursday, January 26, 2023 / 12 pm, the entire Panorama parking lot is closed to the public and available as required to the police and WEF. Part of the parking lot is opened for the four HCD home matches Tuesday, January 3, Friday, January 6, Tuesday, Sunday, January 22, and Tuesday, January 24, 2023.

3.9 Closure of pedestrian paths in the Kurpark

Starting Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 7 am through Monday, January 23, 2023 / 6 pm, the pedestrian paths in the Kurpark (Carl-Dorno path and Jules-Federmann path), between the Congress Center and the Ice stadium, as well as the access to the swimming pool are closed.

3.10 Partial closure Reginaweg / Alteinstrasse

Starting Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 2 pm through Friday, January 20, 2023 / 6 pm, access to Reginaweg and Alteinstrasse is only possible via the Talstrasse. Access from and to the Promenade is blocked.

3.11 Closure Symondsstrasse

Starting Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 2 pm through Friday, January 20, 2023 / 6 pm, the Symondstrasse will be closed between the Promenade and Richtstattweg.

3.12 Closure Obere Strasse

Between Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 5:00 pm and Friday, January 20, 2023 / 6:00 pm, the Obere Strasse will be closed in the area around the Hotel Steigenberger Belvédère. VBD Davos and emergency responders are exempted from this measure.

3.13 Closure of Dorfstrasse:

On Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 5 pm through Friday, January 20, 2023 / 6 pm, the Dorfstrasse is closed between the entrance to the SPAR parking lot and the Hotel Seedorf. The Salzgäbastrasse behind the Seehof is closed to pedestrian traffic.

3.14 Delays and temporary closure Flüelastrasse

Starting Sunday, January 15, 2023 / 8:00 am through Friday, January 20, 2023 / 6:00 pm, expect delays on the Flüelastrasse between the intersection at Bahnhofstrasse Sagenstutz (above Fährich) as well as temporary closures. A section of this route is used as a waiting area and traffic may be detoured with traffic signs.

3.15 Closure Lake parking lot / Lake promenade

Starting Monday, January 2, 2023 / 7:00 am through Wednesday, January 25, 2023 / 6:00 pm, the entire lake parking is closed to the public and available as required to the police and WEF. A temporary public parking lot will be set up along the Flüelastrasse Höhe at Stilli as a replacement. The lake promenade can be reached from there on foot over the Stillistrasse.

The lake promenade is closed between the lake parking lot and the Strandbad as of Thursday, January 12, 2023 / 7:00 am through Wednesday, January 25, 2023 / 6:00 pm for all traffic as well as pedestrians. Signs mark the detour of the path around the lake.

4 Special order for public transportation

Between Monday, January 16 and Friday, January 20, 2023 buses will be operating under a special WEF schedule (changed VBD lines and times). Individual bus stops will be moved or closed starting Monday, January 9 through Monday, January 23, 2023. More detailed information to be published in January in the Davoser Zeitung, on vbd.ch, in the SBB online schedule, and directly in buses and bus stops.

Public transportation may be closed in part or completely for any traffic disturbances, demonstrations, etc.

5 Limited parking and places to stop

- 5.1 Parking and stopping during the set up and taking down of the facilities along the indicated sections of road requires a permit by the municipality for the assigned locations. Submit any applications to the Davos Office of Public Safety (081 414 30 30) as early as possible.
- 5.2 Vehicles not permitted or that hinder traffic as well as any vehicles that cannot be identified, are removed at the expense of the impacted party. The legal owner can retrieve towed vehicles against payment for costs (transportation and parking) at the Cantonal Police Grisons.

6 General Instructions

6.1 Provisional traffic recommendation

You should anticipate traffic jams along the Talstrasse between the cutoff Albana and the Hertistrasse. For this reason, we recommend using the marked detour via the Matta and Dischmastrasse when driving from Davos Platz to Davos Dorf.

6.2 Traffic delays

In advance of and during the WEF 2023, expect traffic delays, changed routes as well as short-term closures throughout the entire Davos road network, especially in the event of any disruptions in traffic resulting, for example, from a demonstration.
