


## WEF 2022 – Air space closure for small aircraft such as hang gliders, model helicopters, models airplanes, drones, and hot air balloons

The Cantonal Police issues, pursuant to Art. 51, para. 3, Aviation Act (LFG; SR 748.0), the following air space closures for small aircraft such as hang gliders, model helicopters, model planes, and drones and hot air balloons.

The closure is issued relating to the air space closure for civil aviation in the greater area of Grisons decreed by the Federal Council in application of the Art. 7 Aviation Act for the duration of the World Economic Forum, for a maximum period of May 20-28, 2022.





- It extends horizontally from Davos Monstein over the Wolfgang pass to the Prättigau to Schiers. It extends vertically from ground to FL 195 (ca. 5950 above sea level).
- A special permit by the Cantonal Police Grisons required to fly in the restricted air space. The Cantonal Police ensures compliance with the air space closue together with the Swiss Air Force.
- 5 Restrictions may be even stricter for brief periods.
- The air space closure enters into effect on May 20, 2022 / 8 am and continues through May 23, 2022 / 5 pm at the latest.
