WEF 2022 - Traffic orders

The Cantonal Police, Grisons and the Municipality of Davos issue the following, temporary traffic orders on the occasion of the WEF 2002 pursuant to Art. 3, para. 6 Swiss Road Act (SVG; SR 741.01):

The following traffic orders apply to increase safety for the entire road system within the Davos: They can be issued or rescinded based on the current situation in the period from Monday, May 2, 2022 through Saturday May 28, 2022 to the extent that individual traffic orders identify another time period.

2 Promenade

2.1 Closure of partial route at the Scaletta Street intersection to the English Church:

Starting on Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 3 pm through Friday, May 27, 2022 / 6 pm, the Promenade will be closed from the turn off Promenade / Scallettastasse to the English Church and traffic will be diverted via the Scalettastrasse. Approved travel is excluded from this measure (VBD until Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 10 pm and as of Friday, May 27, 2022 / 5 am). Travel with permits in on-coming traffic is permitted between the Scalettastrasse intersection and the Hertistrasse.

2.2 Closure of intersection at the Montana crossing to Hotel Parsenn:

Starting Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 10 am through Friday, May 27, 2022 / 6 pm, the Promenade in the area of Hotel Seehof, between the Montana intersection and the Hotel Parsenn will be closed. Travel with pemits is excluded from this measure. Traffic will be routed to the Talstrasse, which is in two-way traffic.

2.3 On-coming traffic on the Promenade; Hotel Parsenn / Café Weber up to Scaletta street

As of Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 10 am through Friday, May 27, 2022 / 6 pm, the Promenade is open to on-coming traffic on the section between the corner Hotel Parsenn / Café Weber up to the intersection at the Scaletta street.

2.4 Scaletta parking log

Starting Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 5 pm, to Friday, May 27, 2022 / 8 am, part of the parking lot at Scaletta next to the access to Hotel Ameron is closed and reserved for the use of the police and WEF.

2.5 Symond parking lot

Starting Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 5 pm through Friday, May 27, 2022 / 6 pm, a section of the parking lot at Symond is closed to the public and made available as required to the police and WEF.

2.6 Horlauben parking lot

Starting Monday, May 2, 2022 / 7 am through Monday, May 30, 2022 / 6 pm, the Horlauben parking lot is closed to the public and available as required to the police and WEF.

2.7 Library parking lot

Starting Thursday, May 19, 2022 / 6 pm through Monday, May 30, 2022 / 6 pm, the library parking lot (Schweizer Haus) is closed to the public and available as required to the police and WEF.

2.8 Separation of the sidewalk along the Promenade

Starting Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 5 pm through Friday, May 27, 2020 / 6 pm, the Promenade is blocked to pedestrian traffic between the Kongress Hotel and the intersection at Scaletta Street at the English Church. Personnel accredited by WEF are excluded by these measures.

3 Talstrasse

3.1 Two-way traffic along the Talstrasse

Starting Sunday, May 8, 2022 / 4 pm through June 3, 2022 / 6 pm, the Talstrasse (Tal Street) will be open to two-way traffic between the Davos Platz train station and the Montana intersection.

3.2 Closure of Congress Center parking lot

Starting Sunday, May 8, 2022 / 7 am through Monday, May 30, 2022 / 6 pm, the Congress Center parking lot is closed for security reasons and available as required for the police and WEF.

3.3 Closure of Metz parking lot

Starting Monday, May 2, 2022 / 7 am through Monday, May 30, 2022 / 6 pm, the entire Metz parking lot is closed to the public and available as required to the police and WEF.

3.4 No turn at intersection Talstrasse / Hertistrasse:

No left turns permitted on to the Talstrasse in the direction of Davos Dorf as of Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 2 pm through Friday, May 27, 2022 / 6 pm. Only right turns permitted from Herti Street (Kongress side) into the Tal Street.

4 Remaining road network

4.1 Closure Hertistrasse

Starting Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 6 pm through Friday, May 27, 2022 / 6 pm, the Hertistrasse will be closed to pedestrians and vehicles between the Promenade and Talstrasse. Personnel accredited by WEF and residents are excluded by these measures.

4.2 Closure Richtstattweg

Starting Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 5 pm through Friday, May 27, 2022 / 6 pm, the Richtstattweg will be closed between the Promenade and Scalettastrasse. Residences and police vehicles are exempted from this measure.

4.3 Closure of Panorama parking lot at the ice stadium

Starting Monday, May 02, 2022 / 7 am through Thursday, June 2, 2022 / 12 pm, the entire Panorama parking lot is closed to the public and available as required to the police and WEF.

4.4 Closure of pedestrian paths in the Kurpark

Starting Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 7 am through Sunday, May 29, 2022 / 6 pm, the pedestrian paths in the Kurpark (Carl-Dorno path and Jules-Federmann path), between the Congress Center and the Ice stadium, as well as the access to the swimming pool are closed.

4.5 Partial closure Reginaweg / Alteinstrasse

Starting Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 2 pm through Friday, May 27, 2022 / 6 pm, access to Reginaweg is only possible via the Talstrasse. Access from and to the Promenade is blocked.

4.6 Closure Symondsstrasse

Starting Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 2 pm through Friday, May 27, 2022 / 6 pm, the Symondstrasse will be closed between the Promenade and Richtstattweg.

4.7 Closure Obere Strasse

Between Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 5 pm and Friday, May 27, 2022 / 6 pm, the Obere Strasse will be closed in the area around the Hotel Steigenberger Belvédère. Emergency services are excluded from this measure.

4.8 Closure of Dorfstrasse:

On Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 5 am through Friday, May 27, 2022 / 6 pm, the Dorfstrasse is closed between the entrance to the SPAR parking lot and the Hotel Seedorf.

4.9 Closure of the sidewalk in the area of Hotel Seehof

Start Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 5 pm through Friday, May 27, 2022 / 6 pm, the Promenade, Dorfstrasse, and Salzgäbastrasse are closed to pedestrians behind the Seehof. Personnel accredited by WEF and residents as well as hotel guests are excluded by these measures.

4.10 Partial closure Mühlestrasse

Starting Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 8 am through Friday, May 27, 2022 / 6 pm, the entrance to the Mühlestrasse is closed as viewed from the Bahnhofstrasse and continued with one-way traffic in the direction of the Bahnhofstrasse. Truck traffic can continue in both directions. The Bünda quarter is accessed via the Museumstrasse.

4.11 Closure Flüelapass

The Flüela Pass is closed between Tschuggen and Susch from Saturday, May 21, 2022 / 6 pm through Thursday, May 26, 2022 / 10 am. Travel with pemits as well as emergency services is excluded from this measure.

5 Special order for public transportation

Starting Sunday May 22 through Thursday, May 26, 2022, buses will only travel on the Promenage in the direction of Davos Platz and detours in the area of the Congress center via the Scalettastrasse. Buses in the directions of Davos Dorf travel exclusively via the Scalettastrasse. Individual bus stops will be moved or closed starting Monday, January 9 through May 30, 2022. More detailed information to be published in May in the Davoser Zeitung, on vbd.ch, in the SBB online schedule, and directly in buses and bus stops.

Public transportation may be closed in part or completely for any traffic disturbances, demonstrations, etc.

6 Limited parking and places to stop

- 6.1 Service vehicles for the security organizations as well as properly identified and labeled vehicles are exempted from the no-parking zones.
- Parking and stopping during the set up and taking down of the facilities along the indicated sections of road requires a permit by the municipality for the assigned locations. Submit any applications to the Davos Office of Public Safety (081 414 30 30) as early as possible.
- Vehicles not permitted or that hinder traffic as well as any vehicles that cannot be identified, are removed at the expense of the impacted party. The legal owner can retrieve towed vehicles against payment for costs (transportation and parking) at the Cantonal Police Grisons.

7 General Instructions

7.1 Provisional traffic recommendation

You should anticipate traffic jams along the Talstrasse between the cutoff Albana and the Hertistrasse. For this reason, we recommend using the marked detour via the Matta and Dischmastrasse when driving from Davos Platz to Davos Dorf.

7.2 Traffic delays

In advance of and during the WEF 2022, expect traffic delays, changed routes as well as short-term closures throughout the entire Davos road network, expecially in the event of any disruptions in traffic resulting, for example, from a demonstration.
